A. Background: International Business Machines (IBM) announced that it would continue support for Enterprise COBOL 4.2 for the z/Operating System (z/OS) through April 2022 and support Enterprise COBOL 5.1 and 5.2 for z/OS until April 2020. Based on the analysis completed and changes implemented, under previously issued CRs, VMS and CWF will fully implement COBOL 6.2 by the April 2021 quarterly release.

CMS will coordinate the testing and implementation of Enterprise COBOL 6.2 for z/OS with the Virtual Data Centers (VDCs) and the CWF Host. All implementations of COBOL 6.2 will be completed using ARCH level 10, enabling the compiler to exploit features in order to achieve the best performance.
