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#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

**A. Background:** MCS User Change Request (CR) 64378 modified the FP screen PJ, PL, and PM segment displays to allow for the display of multiple procedure code ranges for a given procedure code/audit with the same effective dates but different end dates. When the CCI job runs, any added procedures or procedures with new effective dates are considered "changed records" and are built on a new record. Each time the CCI job runs, a new record will be created, but only the procedures that change with this CCI run will be on the new record. The procedures are no longer merged together onto one record. Before this change, the records would be displayed in MCS Desk Top (MCSDT) "together" on the most current effective date, making one large record. Now, only the records that actually "changed" are on the new record, so users may not find the record that they want as the first record.

The purpose of this CR is to ensure CCI code pairs with multiple effective dates display together on the CCI screens. This CR will also add a new search feature for audit-related procedure code pairs. This will allow for more efficient research, and prevent errors from customer care associates who could not locate the code pair with the correct effective dates.
