Medicare and Medicaid Notice to the Public

Notice is hereby given that on July 31, 2024, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will terminate the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Oasis at Austin, Austin, TX as a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program. In addition, as authorized by the Texas State Medicaid Agency, notice is given that the provider's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will also be terminated effective July 31, 2024.

CMS has determined that Oasis at Austin has failed to attain substantial compliance with the following Medicare and Medicaid participation requirements:

- 42 CFR 483.25 – Quality of Care
- 42 CFR 483.90 – Physical Environment

The Medicare program will not make payment for skilled nursing facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after May 16, 2024. For residents admitted prior to May 16, 2024, payment may continue for up to 30 days of services on or after July 31, 2024, the date of termination.

In addition, Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after May 16, 2024. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to May 16, 2024, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to 30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after July 31, 2024, the date of termination.
