



CMS Section 508 Program Tip #5: Fields Labels



This Monthly Tip Series falls under the Program Pillar of Policy and Program Administration.

Field labels carry a "high impact" consideration and should be prioritized during development and remediation.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT

In order for assistive technology users to understand and successfully complete a given task, form fields must have labels that are programmatically defined.

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Ensure all form input controls have a meaningful and unique accessible name:
 - Programmatically associate the visual label with its field using the label tag for attribute. The value must match the ID of the field.
- 2. Relative form controls (check boxes, radio buttons, and multi-part fields) must be labeled. Use the FIELDSET and LEGEND tags.
