Termination Notice

Notice to Public Revocation of Pharmasan Labs, Inc.'s CLIA Certificate

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing notice that on December 26, 2017, the Pharmasan Labs, Inc. 375 280th St Bldg A Osceola, WI 54020 CLIA certificate #52D0914898 was revoked due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements.

The facility has been notified that the CLIA certificate was revoked on December 26, 2017. When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is revoked, it is required to cease all patient laboratory testing, including waived and provider performed microscopy testing and regardless of whether or not the laboratory charges for the testing. In addition, CLIA regulations prohibit the laboratory's owner, Mieke Kellerman and its director, Dr. Bruce E. Hyde & Dr. Gottfried Kellerman, from owning, operating, or directing any laboratory for two years from the date of the revocation, or until December 26, 2019. CMS is committed to patient safety and quality of care.
