Title Limitation of CLIA Certificate

Rocky Mountain Oncology, 53D1049790

On **August 4, 2026**, the laboratory's CLIA certificate, located at 6501 East 2nd Street, Casper, WY 82609 will be limited **for the analyte of Chloride (CL)** due to their failure to meet CLIA requirements.

The laboratory was notified on July 20, 2026.

When a laboratory's CLIA certificate is **limited**, it will not be permitted to perform any testing for the purpose of providing information for the diagnosis, prevention, treatment of any disease or impairment of, or the assessment of the health of human beings, in the testing area where it is limited. The laboratory may continue to perform parallel testing on specimens if needed to implement corrective actions; however, the laboratory may not report any test results during the period of limitation.
