Subject: CY 2027 Medicare Part C and D Reporting Requirements-30-day Comment Period

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is announcing an opportunity for Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs), Part D sponsors, and other interested parties to comment on the proposed CY 2027 Medicare Part C and D Reporting Requirements. CMS has combined the two separate Paperwork Reduction Act (PRA) packages (OMB Control Numbers 0938-1054 for Part C and 0938-0992 for Part D) into a single PRA package to streamline reporting processes and reduce administrative burden.

CMS has reviewed all comments submitted during the 60-day comment period and has incorporated clarifications into the updated materials where appropriate. Comments not addressed at this time will be considered for future revisions.

The following changes are proposed for the 30-day comment period.

- New element added to the Supplemental Benefit Utilization and Costs section
- Increased burden hours for the Enrollment/Disenrollment Section
- Updated D?SNP Enrollee Advisory Committee reporting section elements
- A few minor revisions to improve consistency and alignment across reporting elements.
