SUBJECT: Information Collection Request (ICR) for the Medicare Transaction Facilitator (MTF) for 2028 under Sections 11001 and 11002 of the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)

The ICR for the Medicare Transaction Facilitator for 2028 under Sections 11001 and 11002 of the IRA (“MTF ICR for 2028”) is now available for a 60-day public comment period, starting on July 24, 2026, and concluding on September 22, 2026. This ICR leverages CMS experience implementing the Medicare Drug Price Negotiation Program (Negotiation Program) and the MTF following the publication of the 2026 and 2027 MTF ICR (OMB control number 0938-1483), which was finalized on May 9, 2025.

Respondents to the forms included in this ICR will include manufacturers of drugs covered under Part D and/or payable under Part B selected for negotiation under the IRA for the initial price applicability year 2028; the dispensing entities and/or Part B providers that dispense the selected drugs to MFP-eligible individuals; third-parties supporting MFP effectuation on behalf of manufacturers, dispensing entities, and/or Part B providers; as well as other interested parties.
