**Title: Plan to Plan Reconciliation**

**Date:** June 24, 2006

**Summary:** Technical instructions for the Plan to Plan Reconciliation process (Phase I - Post Enrollment Reconciliation).

**Title: Compliance with HIPAA Administrative Simplification Provisions**

**Date:** June 24, 2006

**Summary:** HIPAA requires the DHHS to adopt standards for electronic transactions and implementation specifications for those transactions, and standard codes to be used in the transactions.

**Title: Q&A Addressing Drug Costs Reported on Prescription Drug Events**

**Date:** June 26, 2006

**Summary:** This note is to apprise Part D organizations of the deadline to submit requests to update bids as a result of any misunderstandings of CMS policy has been extended. CMS will communicate with you further as to the cut-off date for resubmitting bids for this purpose.

**Title: CRT-D Payment Clarification**

**Date:** June 23, 2006

**Summary:** In 2005, an NCD was issued regarding expanded Medicare coverage of Implantable Cardioverter Defibrillators (ICDs coded 37.94) to prevent sudden death in people with heart disease. Since this NCD met the significant cost threshold, CMS made payments on a fee-for-service basis for the ICD costs meeting the expanded coverage criteria for services provided on or after January 27, 2005 through December 31, 2005. Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs) were not liable for payment for costs

relating directly to the provision of services related to the ICDs until their payments were appropriately adjusted to take into account the cost of the NCD. The rates of the MAOs were appropriately adjusted effective January 1, 2006. This memorandum addresses the inquiry which has been raised regarding the payment responsibility for the CRT-D device (00.51) versus the AICD device (37.94) for which there is a national coverage determination.

**Title: 2005 Financial Statements- Late Submissions**

**Date:** June 30, 2006

**Summary:** As required under the Fiscal Soundness Reporting Requirements (FSRR), these annual audited financial statements were due to CMS by April 30, 2006. Your organization missed this deadline and therefore is not in compliance with your Medicare Advantage contracting obligations under CFR 42 422.516(a)(5). Please provide CMS with the required annual audited financial statement information no later than Wednesday July 12, 2006.

**Title: Announcement regarding Late Enrollment Penalties for plan year 2006**

**Date:** June 30, 2006

**Summary:** This notice describes the impact of the LEP demonstration on the plans' requirements for reviewing and reporting creditable coverage. It also indicates that further guidance on plans' roles in reviewing and reporting creditable coverage is forthcoming.

**Title: Release Medicare Health Outcomes Survey 2005 Cohort 8 Baseline Reports in HPMS**

**Date:** June 23, 2006

**Summary:** On behalf of the entire Medicare Health Outcomes Survey (HOS) Team, CMS is announcing the distribution of the HOS 2005 Cohort 8 Baseline Report for all participating Medicare Advantage Plans.

**Title: Special TRR Communication- Week-at-a-Glance June 26<sup>th</sup> through June 30<sup>th</sup> (Revised)**

**Date:** June 30, 2006

**Summary:** Plans were advised that the target date for the Special TRRs provided might be altered due to system resources and other factors. It was also stated that the MMAHelp Desk would communicate any changes to the schedule that occur after the memo was published to Plans.

**Title: Special TRR Communication- Week-at-a-Glance July 1<sup>st</sup> through July 8<sup>th</sup>**

**Date:** June 30, 2006

**Summary:** The following communication describes the Special TRRs that CMS is preparing to send to Plans during the week of July 1, 2006. It also includes special notices detailing system availability. The focus of the TRRs is described in the communication.

**Title: Announcement regarding Late Enrollment Penalties for plan year 2006**

**Date:** June 30, 2006

**Summary:** According to the Medicare Modernization Act statute and regulations, an LEP will be assessed by CMS for each full calendar month following a beneficiary's Initial Enrollment Period (IEP), which falls during any continuous period of 63 days or longer.

**Title: CY 2007 Annual Notice of Change**

**Date:** June 30, 2006

**Summary:** Today we are releasing for comment the 2007 draft Annual Notice of Change (ANOC) for Medicare Advantage Organizations, Demonstrations and Medicare Cost plans. The draft ANOCs includes specific changes in Medicare and plan benefits, plan premiums and plan rules effective January 1, 2007. In particular, the revised draft ANOCs contains information specific to the Medicare Part D Benefit, Open Enrollment Period limitations and important information for beneficiaries receiving extra help.
