SUBJECT: Information Regarding CY 2014 Medicare Plan Finder (MPF) Submissions by Medicare-Medicaid Plans (MMPs)

The purpose of this memo is to announce a delay for pending Medicare-Medicaid Plan (MMP) contracts' submissions of biweekly Medicare Plan Finder (MPF) data, to reiterate upcoming MPF test data submission periods, and to clarify data requirements specific for MMP contracts.

As a reminder, MMP contracts are required to submit drug pricing data to be displayed on the MPF tool on [www.medicare.gov](http://www.medicare.gov). This process involves submissions of test data as well as biweekly submissions of drug pricing data. Submitted pricing data will go through quality assurance analyses to identify outliers or potential data errors. These identified outliers will be communicated to each contract.

Given the mid-2014 target start dates for MMP enrollment in most states, MMP contract information (with the exception of MMP contracts in Massachusetts) for CY 2014 will not appear in MPF starting in October 2013. Instead, MMP contract information will display in MPF starting later in 2013 or in 2014 depending on the marketing and enrollment start dates for MMPs in each state. We will therefore delay the start of the biweekly drug pricing data submissions for MMP contracts (except MMP contracts in Massachusetts) until closer to the display date. We will provide more specific guidance on the MPF timelines for MMP contracts closer to each state's demonstration start date.

However, this flexibility of schedules means that MMP contracts will not have an additional opportunity to test their pricing files prior to beginning the required biweekly pricing data submissions either later this year or in 2014, dependent on each state's schedule [for implementation](#). If there are errors with the pricing files that cannot be corrected prior to the scheduled display of MMP contract information in MPF, information for that MMP contract will be suppressed in MPF until the data issues are resolved. Therefore, we strongly encourage MMP contracts to take advantage of upcoming test data submissions process. The next MPF Pricing Data test submission period is Thursday, July 25 to Friday July 26, 2013. The final test submission period is Thursday, August 22 to Friday, August 23, 2013.

We also clarify that MMP contracts will submit drug pricing data for Part D drugs only. For CY 2014, any other drugs covered by MMP contracts pursuant to Medicaid coverage requirements (e.g., drugs on the Additional Demonstration Drug, or ADD, file) will not be included in the drug pricing files.
