SUBJECT: Part C Risk Scores for the Risk Adjustment Models Discussed in the Payment Year (PY) 2024 Advance Notice

On February 1, 2023 CMS published the 2024 Advance Notice,¹ which discusses the proposed Part C risk adjustment model for payment year 2024. This memo is to inform Medicare Advantage organizations that CMS has posted plan-level risk scores on HPMS for your review; these risk scores are to support your evaluation of the proposed revisions to the CMS-HCC model in 2024 Advance Notice. The posted risk scores are calculated with the Part C risk adjustment model in use for payment in 2023, as well as the models discussed in the 2024 Advance Notice. Risk scores and accompanying technical notes can be found in the Risk Adjustment module of HPMS under the heading “Proposed PY2024 Part C Model Risk Scores.”

In addition, the diagnosis to HCC mappings are available on the CMS risk adjustment webpage (found [here](#)).

All risk scores posted on HPMS are PY 2021 risk scores, calculated with diagnoses from 2020 dates of service. Risk scores provided include those calculated using the 2020 CMS-HCC model, the revised CMS-HCC model proposed for PY 2024 (V28 model), as well as risk scores calculated using a version of the proposed CMS-HCC model that does not include the Principle 10-focused clinical updates (V27 model).
