SUBJECT: Availability of 2021 Medicare Health Outcomes Survey (HOS) Baseline Reports and 2021 Medicare HOS-Modified (HOS-M) Reports and Electronic Data

This memo announces availability of the *2021 Medicare HOS Cohort 24 Baseline Report* for participating Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs), Cost Plans, and Demonstrations, and the *2021 Medicare HOS-M Report* and electronic data for Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) organizations that continue to participate in the program.

2021 Medicare HOS Cohort 24 Baseline Report

The *2021 Medicare HOS Cohort 24 Baseline Report* includes results from the Medicare HOS 3.0, as administered in 2021 (see the September 8, 2020 HPMS memo “Reporting Requirements for HEDIS® Measurement Year (MY) 2020, HOS, and CAHPS® Measures, and Information Regarding HOS and HOS-M for Frailty.”) The HOS Baseline Report provides information for MAOs, Cost Plans, and Demonstrations to help identify opportunities for improvement. Information is displayed that indicates where health plans are performing better or worse than the national average. Aggregate and state-level information is provided to MAOs for internal review. Also included in each report zip file is a summary data file with contract-level responses to each HOS question, summary measures, and demographic data related to the report.

2021 Medicare HOS-M Report

The Medicare HOS-M, an abbreviated version of the Medicare HOS, assesses the physical and mental health functioning of enrollees in PACE organizations and generates information for payment adjustment. The *2021 HOS-M Report* focuses on specialized plans serving frail and elderly beneficiaries, and provides a summary of demographic information, physical and mental health status, and selected health status measures compared to national averages. CMS encourages each participating PACE organization to examine their results for use in quality improvement activities.

Distribution of Baseline and HOS-M Reports

Reports are distributed electronically to participating MAOs, Cost Plans, Demonstrations, and PACE organizations through HPMS. To access your organization's reports, from the HPMS top navigation bar select "Quality and Performance," then "HOS," then "Reports," then "Baseline Reports" or "HOS-M Feedback Reports" from the dashboard. Baseline Reports for Cohorts 21-24 and HOS-M Reports for 2018-2021 are available in HPMS. MAOs, Cost Plans, Demonstrations, and PACE organizations are encouraged to examine their results and may visit the HOS website at www.HOSonline.org for information, webinars, and additional resources addressing how the HOS data can be used to target quality improvement activities. Please note that if your organization did not participate in the 2021 Cohort 24 Baseline or the 2021 HOS-M, there are no plan-specific reports for your organization.

Distribution of 2021 HOS-M Electronic Data

The 2021 Medicare HOS-M beneficiary-level data are now available for PACE organizations that continue to participate in the program.

Participating PACE organizations may obtain their data from the Health Services Advisory Group (HSAG) by emailing HOS Information and Technical Support at hos@hsag.com. Please provide your organization's designated recipient of these data, your plan's mailing address, the recipient's e-mail address, return telephone number, and CMS contract number(s). The data are available for distribution to PACE organizations at no cost, and will be provided via secure file transfer, formatted as an encrypted CSV (comma-separated values) file.
