Subject: Draft Medicare Part C Reporting Requirements for CY2021-30 Day Notice

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is announcing an opportunity for Medicare Advantage Organizations and other stakeholders to comment on the proposed Medicare Part C Reporting Requirements data for the 2021 collection period. This notice announces the suspension of the Additional Telehealth Benefits (ATB) reporting requirements for the 2021 contract year. To ensure accurate ATB reporting for the 2020 contract year, all technical questions and answers relevant to ATB reporting will remain in the 2021 Part C Technical Reporting Requirements and will include additional guidance for data element B.
