SUBJECT: Week-at-a-Glance February 24th through March 2nd

The Week-at-a-Glance memo describes the cleanups that CMS is preparing to transmit along with Plan-submitted transactions to Plans over the next two weeks. The focus of each cleanup is described below.

Due to systems processing, the weekly TRR will be transmitted on Sundays for the next several months, however Plans should be aware that system resources and other factors might alter this schedule. CMS will advise Plans when the weekly TRR will return to its regular Saturday transmission schedule.

Plans should also be aware that all information is approximate and subject to change. The MMAHelp Desk will communicate any changes to the schedule that occur after this memo is published to Plans.

Re-enroll Beneficiaries who were Disenrolled Erroneously

IMPORTANT: This information has been updated.

During the November 2007 auto-enrollment process for 2008 enrollments, CMS identified a software issue that caused MA-only beneficiaries with dual enrollment eligibility to be erroneously auto-disenrolled from one of the contracts.

In order to close the loop with the Plans, CMS will reprocess transactions for impacted beneficiaries where no subsequent successful enrollment into a non 'S' or 'E' contracts has been processed after November 12, 2007.

Plans should expect to see MA-only beneficiaries successfully enrolled into the correct PDP contract and receive an accepted status along with a legitimate TRC. Payment adjustments may also occur depending on the requested effective date of the enrollment transaction.

As a result of the reprocessing, Plans can expect to receive one of the following Transaction Reply Codes (TRCs):

- 011 ENROLLMENT ACCEPTED AS SUBMITTED
- 016 ENROLLMENT ACCEPTED, OUT OF AREA
