The Week-at-a-Glance memo describes the cleanups that CMS is preparing to transmit along with regular scheduled replies to MAO/PDP submitted Transaction Files over the next two weeks. The focus of each cleanup is described below.

MAO/PDPs should also be aware that all information is approximate and subject to change. The MMA Help Desk will communicate any changes to the schedule that occur after this memo is published.

Disenrollment Transaction for Overlapping Enrollment Periods

CMS has identified an issue where overlapping enrollments were being incorrectly processed. This has resulted in conflicting information being stored in the enrollment history for some eneficiaries.

CMS will reprocess select transactions to identify and correct these overlapping enrollments.

This cleanup will reprocess enrollments in which:

- The beneficiary was enrolled in two distinct, valid Contracts with a single overlapping period that began on or after January 1, 2006; or
- The beneficiary was enrolled in the same contract with the same Plan Benefit Package (PBP) or no PBPs, with a single overlapping period that began on or after January 1, 2006.

MAO/PDPs should expect to receive TRCs on the TRR indicating that the beneficiaries have been disenrolled, thus causing payment adjustments populated to the MMR.
