Indexes:

Advanced Search:

5. Removed the Advanced Search tab from the MCD. All search functionality has been consolidated into the new Search function.

6. Updated the Medicare Coverage Document Type Descriptions document which can be found in the MCD Info & Tips section of the Help & Resources page.
7. Updated the How To – Reports and How To - Downloads documents in the MCD Info & Tips section of the Help & Resources page.
8. Removed the How To – Advanced Search and How To – Indexes documents from the MCD Info & Tips section of the Help & Resources page.
9. Updated the Browser Information statement on the Help & Resources page to indicate that Google Chrome has replaced Internet Explorer 11 as the default CMS browser.
10. Added a tour of the new Reports to the Help (question mark) icon. The tour is called "Tour the Reports".
11. Moved the tour of the new Search to the Help (question mark) icon. The tour is called "Tour the Search".

Search:

12. Moved the See Also section above the Selected Criteria section on the Search Results page.

Settings:

13. Added a Reset Search Data feature to the Settings (gear) icon. This tool can be used to manually clear the cache on the rare occasion when Search data has not been refreshed properly.
