The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing an opportunity for public comment as it continues to administer the mandatory reporting requirements added by Section 111 of the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Extension Act of 2007 (MMSEA) (P.L.110-173) for group health plan (GHP) arrangements and for Liability Insurance (including Self-Insurance), No-Fault Insurance, and Workers' Compensation. See 42 U.S.C. 1395y(b)(7) & (8).

- Please make the title in the subject line of your comments as specific as possible. Specificity will allow CMS to sort and address incoming e-mails more readily.

- This e-mail address will allow CMS to receive the widest input possible. CMS will use the comments received, in part, in deciding if there are additional issues that CMS should address on the website or user guides containing instructions for reporting under Section 111. Questions and comments received will also be addressed on Town Hall Teleconferences as appropriate.
