SUBJECT:	Contract Year (CY) 2013 SNP Model of Care (MOC) Training and Technical Assistance Call Schedule

The purpose of this memorandum is to announce a series of training and technical assistance calls hosted by CMS to assist SNPs with preparing and improving their MOC submissions for the CY 2013 application cycle.

CMS will host two separate training calls on MOC elements 1-5 and 6-11, respectively. During these calls, SNPs will have the opportunity to ask questions that relate specifically to the relevant MOC elements. We strongly encourage MAOs' clinical and quality improvement staff to participate in these calls. The MOC elements and scoring criteria can be found in Appendix 1 of Chapter 16-B of the Medicare Managed Care Manual at: https://www.cms.gov/manuals/downloads/mc86c16b.pdf.

Please note that we will not cover topics related to general MA application requirements during these calls. Those topics are addressed in separate calls that CMS is hosting.
