On April 6, 2010, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) issued a new regulation (4085-F) providing for a series of policy and technical changes to the Medicare Part C and D programs. That rule appeared in the Federal Register on April 15, 2010 (75 FR 19678). One of the requirements in this rule is that each Part C and Part D sponsor be subject to an independent yearly audit of Part C and Part D measures (collected pursuant to our reporting requirements) to determine their reliability, validity, completeness, and comparability in accordance with specifications developed by us. The collection request for the independent yearly audit appeared in the Federal Register on April 19, 2010 (75 FR 20366). This letter is to inform you that five documents related to this data validation requirement have been published to the CMS website pursuant to the Paperwork Reduction Act (PRA). The five documents included for review and comment are:

- 1. Organizational Assessment Instrument
- 2. Data Validation Standards
- 3. Instructions for Findings Data Collection Form
- 4. Findings Data Collection Forms
- 5. Sampling Instructions
