We are pleased to announce that the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has approved the Information Collection Request (ICR), sometimes referred to as the "PRA", for the new Part C Medicare Advantage and 1876 Cost Plan Reporting Requirements that were initially published in the Federal Register on June 26, 2008 ("60-day notice"), and subsequently published in the Federal Register on October 3, 2008 ("30 day notice"). The final 2009 Part C Reporting Requirements are posted at the following web path:

We are also releasing a Technical Specifications document for the CY2009 Part C Reporting Requirements. These Technical Specifications are identical in content to the information included in the 2009 Part C Reporting Requirements document and do not alter or add to the data collection described therein. Rather, the technical document provides a simplified, user-friendly guide to the information that received OMB clearance. Specifically, we have organized the Technical Specifications document to clearly present the Reporting Requirements in a standardized format, including data element definitions and additional notes which offer clarifications derived from the responses to comments received under the OMB clearance process. This document will be posted at the same location as the 2009 Part C Reporting Requirements both on the external CMS website and on the HPMS Plan Reporting site.
