Supplemental CMS Episode Groups Posting

As required by section 1848(r) of the Social Security Act, as added by section 101(f) of the Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act of 2015 (MACRA), Pub. L. 114-10, enacted April 16, 2015, CMS posted for public comment on October 15, 2015 the CMS Episode Groups Summary document and supporting technical documentation. The purpose of that document was to provide background and context to solicit stakeholder input on the episode groups that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) developed pursuant to section 1848(n)(9) of the Social Security Act.

An initial set of 34 episode groups was posted on our website on October 15, 2015, and was designated as Method A. Method B was developed by the Center for Medicare to complement those efforts and provide a robust measure set in the Supplemental QRUR reports. At the time of the posting, CMS was in the middle of developing additional Method A episode groups and has since completed them. The final set of 57 Method A episode groups and the accompanying documentation are now being posted for public comment.
