

Ambulatory Specialty Model

To help you prepare for the Ambulatory Specialty Model (ASM), please complete the following activities.



1. Confirm your participation in ASM.

Review the [ASM Participants dataset](#) to confirm your participation in ASM.

If you are listed in the ASM Participants dataset but did not receive a notification email from AmbulatorySpecialtyModel@cms.hhs.gov, please register for the ASM Participant Portal using your National Provider Identifier (NPI) to verify your participation and update your contact information.



2. Register for the ASM Participant Portal.

The [ASM Participant Portal](#) is your primary hub for ASM onboarding and administrative activities. After registering for the portal, please complete these high-priority tasks:

- **Review and update your participant profile.** Confirm that your organization's legal name, email address, mailing address, and other contact information are accurate.
- **Add additional organizational contacts.** You may add colleagues who will help support your participation in ASM.
- **Notify CMS of organization changes.** If you are no longer affiliated with the organization (TIN) where you were selected as an ASM participant, submit an Organization Change Request through the ASM Participant Portal.
- **Prepare to access beneficiary-identifiable data.** Registering for an ASM Participant Portal account and adding the relevant contacts will facilitate the signing of the ASM Data Sharing Agreement form and ASM Data Disclosure Request and Attestation form once available.
