I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: In a continued effort to standardize processes within the Medicare Shared Systems, the Fiscal Intermediary Shared System (FISS) maintainer shall conduct the analysis to determine the effort needed to modify the process in which the internal crosswalk file can be updated from the nightly PECOS extract file.

Currently, the FISS shared system maintainer (SSM) receives the nightly PECOS extract file and sends the National Provider Identifier (NPI) combinations from the PECOS file for a particular Online Survey Certification and Reporting System (OSCAR) number to the NPI crosswalk contractor. The NPI crosswalk contractor sends FISS back an NPI crosswalk file with the NPI/OSCAR combinations. The FISS system will then apply those updates to the internal crosswalk files.

This process has been problematic when the information from the NPI crosswalk contractor is not accurate. The other SSMs are updating the data from PECOS and only sending the ones needing a manual match to the NPI crosswalk contractor. The analysis being conducted with this change request (CR) will provide the information needed for a future CR to modify the processing of the nightly PECOS extract file standardizing this process for all the SSMs.
