I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: The Enrollment Data Base (EDB) sends Medicare beneficiary/legal rep addresses to the Common Working File (CWF) in a standard format irrespective of the type of address, either national or foreign. Fiscal Intermediary Shared System (FISS) and Multi-Carrier System (MCS) currently receive the address from CWF, but are unable to identify and populate City, State, and/or Country necessary for Healthcare Integrated General Ledger Accounting System (HIGLAS) to process payments and/or send Remittance Advices (RAs) to entities outside the United States.

During the analysis of CR 10428, EDB noted that the 3-byte numeric 'Consular Code' in the 'Zip Code' field of the beneficiary/legal rep address to CWF shall be used to derive the 'Country Code' to indicate the type of address.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is requesting the impacted systems to implement procedure(s) to properly handle foreign addresses.

B. Policy: This CR does not involve any legislative or regulatory policies.
