A. Background: Currently, the SuperOp sub-system allows an operator to cross-copy a single SuperOp event or value set. The Cross-copy function is a timesaving method used by Durable Medical Equipment Medicare Administrative Contractors (DME MACs) for copying either a SuperOp event or value set from one CICS region to another. For example, a DME MAC can establish and test a SuperOp event in the UAT region and once tested the event can be cross-copied to the DME MAC's production region eliminating the need to re-enter the SuperOp event.
