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I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: Medicare providers submitting claims to Medicare contractors for Part B services use a HCPCS code to indicate the service that was rendered. The updated HCPCS file containing the HCPCS codes is released annually to Medicare contractors via CMS' mainframe telecommunications system. If any adjustments/updates are needed, the contractors shall be notified by an email from CMS to the CMS Functional Workgroups. The email will include instructions to implement the adjustments/updates.

The alphanumeric index and the table of drugs will also be posted to the CMS website in early November. The website address is https://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/HCPCSReleaseCodeSets/Alpha-Numeric-HCPCS.html.
