SUBJECT: Multi-Carrier System (MCS) Reporting of 2003 Participating Data to the Contractor Reporting of Operational & Workload Data (CROWD) System

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' (CMS) Participating Physician/Supplier Program for calendar year 2003 has two enrollment periods: January 9 through February 28, 2003, and March 1 through April 14, 2003. Having two enrollment periods changes the reporting format that you normally follow in reporting this data to the CROWD system. Carriers on the ViPs system are able to report the data for the two periods to CROWD without system changes. MCS carriers can report data from the first enrollment period (January 9 through February 28) without systems changes. However, MCS will have to make a system change in order to report the data for the second enrollment period (March 1, 2003 through April 14, 2003).

B. Policy:

The purpose of this Program Memorandum (PM) is to instruct the MCS system to make the appropriate system change in order to report the necessary participating data from the second enrollment period to CMS.

NOTE: The HPBSS standard system and associated carriers are waived from implementing this Change Request due to their upcoming transition to the MCS system. These

carriers are required to implement the Change Request once they transition to MCS.
