I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES: CMS published the SNF payment rates for FY 2005 (that is, beginning October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005), in the Federal Register on July 30, 2004 (69 FR 45775). The update methodology is identical to that used in the previous year and will include the reimbursement of beneficiaries with AIDS. The statute mandates an update to the Federal rates using the latest SNF full market basket.

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SUBJECT: Medicare Part A Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Prospective Payment System (PPS) Pricer Update FY 2006

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

This attachment provides information on the updates to the payment rates used under the PPS for SNFs, for FY 2006, as required by statute.

A. Background: Annual updates to the PPS rates are required by §1888(e) of the Social Security Act, as amended by the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Balanced Budget Refinement Act of 1999 (the BBRA), and the Medicare, Medicaid and SCHIP Benefits Improvement and Protection Act of 2000 (the BIPA), relating to Medicare payments and consolidated billing for SNFs.

B. Policy: CMS published the SNF payment rates for FY 2005 (that is, beginning October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005), in the **Federal Register** on July 30, 2004 (69 FR 45775). The update methodology is identical to that used in the previous year and will include the reimbursement of beneficiaries with AIDS. The statute mandates an update to the Federal rates using the latest SNF full market basket.

The SNF Wage Index notice will be effective October 1, 2005, and published in the **Federal Register** before that date. A transitional wage index will apply for federal fiscal year 2006 according to the methodology described in the **Federal Register**.
