I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: In an effort to ensure that beneficiaries are receiving the best possible care from Medicare providers, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) want to increase the number of detail lines, which can be submitted to the claims processing systems, as well as, the downstream systems. The CMS believes that there is a need to expand the downstream systems to allow for 50 detail lines.

Currently for Part B claims, the Common Working File (CWF) communicates detail specific error codes using an asterisk ("*") in the third position of the error code field. The detail line number associated with the error code is separately communicated using the CWF Trailer 39. This mechanism is different and less efficient than the method used to communicate detail error information on Part A claims. The modification to the CWF Trailer 08 will benefit all impacted parties by introducing a consistent and more efficient mechanism for communication of claim detail level error code information. The CWF Trailer 08 changes are preparatory and necessary for the expansion to fifty claim details.

Note: The changes for this CR are effective based on receipt date and not on date of service.

B. Policy: The 2006 Tax Relief and Health Care Act (TRHCA) (P.L. 109-432) required the establishment of a physician quality reporting system, including an incentive payment for eligible professionals who satisfactorily report data on quality measures for covered professional services furnished to Medicare beneficiaries.
