Contractors will determine radiopharmaceutical payment allowance limits based on the methodology in place as of November 2003. Transmittal 528 (CR 3783), dated April 22, 2005, states that contractors will determine payment limits for radiopharmaceuticals based on invoice pricing. This notice supersedes Transmittal 528.

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SUBJECT: Calendar Year 2005 Payment for Medicare Part B Radiopharmaceuticals Not Paid on a Cost or Prospective Payment Basis

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: Section 303(c) of the Medicare Modernization Act of 2003 (MMA) revises the payment methodology for Part B covered drugs that are not paid on a cost or prospective payment basis. Per the MMA, beginning January 1, 2005, drugs and biologicals not paid on a cost or prospective payment basis will be paid based on the ASP methodology. However, for radiopharmaceuticals, section 303(h) of the MMA provides for continuation of the payment methodology under Part B prior to the MMA.

Transmittal 528 (CR 3783), dated April 22, 2005, states that contractors will determine payment limits for radiopharmaceuticals based on invoice pricing. This notice supersedes Transmittal 528.

B. Policy: For dates of service on or after January 1, 2005, the payment allowance limits for radiopharmaceuticals are not subject to ASP. Contractors will determine payment limits for radiopharmaceuticals based on the methodology in place as of November 2003.
