Re: Risk Adjustment Data Validation (RADV) Industry-wide Training and Audits Reminder

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid (CMS) Center for Program Integrity sent an initial notification on December 20th about our intent to host an industry wide Medicare Advantage RADV training on January 29, 2019, at 1:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time (EST). The training will provide an overview of the RADV program and the audience for the training includes the following organization types:

- Medicare Advantage Organizations (MAOs)
- Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE)
- Cost Plans (1876 Cost HMOs/CMPs and 1833 HCPPs)
- Certain Demonstration Projects (MMPs, etc.)
- Third Party Submitters

Registration for training will open January 14th and close January 28th. Register for the January 29th training at [RADV Industry wide training](#) from January 14th at 9:00 a.m. EST until January 28th at 1:00 p.m.

As noted in our December 20th communication, CMS will share additional information regarding Contract-Level RADV audits for payment years 2014 and 2015 at the training.
