SUBJECT: Release of Minnesota Senior Health Options Final Contract Year 2020 Model Materials

Attached to this memorandum are the new model materials for Contract Year (CY) 2020 developed jointly by CMS and Minnesota for Minnesota Senior Health Options (MSHO) D-SNPs operating in the Minnesota Demonstration to Align Administrative Functions for Improvements in Beneficiary Experience.

As a result of the implementation of CMS-4185-F, Contract Year 2020 Medicare Advantage and Part D Flexibility, which may be found in the Final Rule published on April 16, 2019 (see <https://www.federalregister.gov/documents/2019/04/16/2019-06822/medicare-and-medicaid-programs-policy-and-technical-changes-to-the-medicare-advantage-medicare>) and CMS-4180-F, Medicare Advantage and Part D Drug Pricing, which may be found in the Final Rule published on May 23, 2019 (see <https://www.federalregister.gov/documents/2019/05/23/2019-10521/modernizing-part-d-and-medicare-advantage-to-lower-drug-prices-and-reduce-out-of-pocket-expenses>), we incorporated related changes into the CY 2020 model materials.

The following materials are included with this guidance:

- **Low Income Subsidy (LIS) Rider**
- **Enrollment Form**
- **Annual Notice of Change (ANOC):** The ANOC must be received by current enrollees by September 30, 2019 and posted on plan websites by October 15, 2019.
- **Member Handbook/Evidence of Coverage (EOC) - Chapters 1-12:** The Member Handbook (or a separate notice to alert enrollees how to access or receive the Member Handbook) must be received by current enrollees by October 15, 2019 and posted on plan websites by October 15, 2019.
- **Summary of Benefits (SB):** The SB must be available by October 15, 2019, but can be

released as early as October 1, 2019, and posted on plan websites by October 15, 2019.

- **Provider and Pharmacy Directory:** The directory (or a separate notice to alert enrollees how to access or receive the directory) must be received by current enrollees no later than October 15, 2019. The directory must be available to current and prospective enrollees and posted on plan websites by October 15, 2019.
- **List of Covered Drugs (Formulary):** The formulary (or a separate notice to alert enrollees how to access or receive the formulary) must be received by current enrollees no later than October 15, 2019 and available to current and prospective enrollees and posted on plan websites by October 15, 2019.
