**Subject:** UPDATE - Estimated Part D risk scores to support 2020 Part D bids

On April 15, 2019, CMS announced the release of Part D risk scores in the HPMS memo “Incoming File from CMS: Beneficiary-level file to support 2020 Part D bids.” We identified a technical issue that resulted in the population of incorrect risk scores on the beneficiary-level files and in the contract-PBP level risk score data on HPMS. We have corrected the issue and refreshed the Part D model risk score estimates in HPMS. In addition, CMS has pushed out an updated beneficiary-level Part D risk score file to all MA-PD plans, 1876 Cost Plans, PACE organizations, and PDPs.

The file name will be constructed as follows:

GENTRAN: P.Rxxxxx.PTD2020.Dyymmdd.Thhmsst.pn

C:D mainframe: zzzzzzz.Rxxxxx.PTD2020.Dyymmdd.Thhmsst

C:D non-mainframe: [directory]P.Rxxxxx.PTD2020.Dyymmdd.Thhmsst

### KEY

xxxxx = 5 character plan contract # yymmdd = two digit year, month, day

hhmsst = hour/minute/second/tenths of second

pn = process number

zzzzzzz = Plan-provided high level qualifier, default is EFTO for production; EFTT for test [directory] = optional directory specified from non-mainframe C:D clients, default is EFTO. for production; EFTT. for test
