MMIS Certification Today

- Process unchanged for the past 30 years
- Occurs + 6 months <u>after</u> commencement of operations
- MMIS = claims processing engine + 4-6 subsystems
- Basis of Review State Medicaid Manual Part 11 functional requirements
- Reviewers rely on "checklists" in functional areas

Why Bother to Change MMIS Cert?



- MITA--Shifting our MMIS Perspective from Subsystems to Business Processes
- Federal Health Architecture/Enterprise View
- Focus on Business Goals not Systems
- As We Alter Our View of the MMIS via MITA We need to Have the MMIS Cert Process Stay in Step—Two Phases
 - Now: Reflects changes in current requirements
 - FFY 2007- 2008: Reflect MITA







Shift Focus and Scope

- Share CMS' certification "checklists" with the States/Vendors to help develop APD, RFP, contract, testing, cert prep and onsite CMS visit
- Re-do checklists to broaden their scope
- Update the range of review criteria within checklists
- Shift focus to <u>beginning</u> of procurement process


ROADMAP TO A SUCCESSFUL MMIS IMPLEMENTATION



Step 1: State Self-Assessment



- ▶ Perform "As is To be" Business Requirements Analysis
- State Performs Self-Assessment Using Business Process
 Model Available in Framework Release 2.0
- Map to Business Areas, Objectives, Processes & Capabilities
- Include: Current & New, Federal and State
- Conduct : Gap Analysis
- Map to MMIS Certification Checklist
- Create New Checklists Update as Changes Occur



Step 2: APD Development

→ Use MMIS Certification Toolkit


- Self Assessment Attachment to APD Map
- Certification Checklists to Business Areas/processes
- Standardizes APD through Use of Templates & Checklists
- State, CMS & Vendor Familiar with Process
- Cost out design, development and installation by Business Process

 & Reviewed Together


Step 6: MMIS Certification Visit
