

Average Monthly Premiums for Second-Lowest Cost Silver Plan and Lowest Cost Plan for States Using the HealthCare.gov Platform, 2016-2019¹

The tables below indicate the average monthly premiums for the second-lowest cost silver plan (SLCSP) and lowest cost plan (LCP) across all 39 states using the HealthCare.gov platform, as well as state-level average SLCSP and LCP premiums. County level premiums are weighted based on county enrollment for the respective plan year, except for 2019 premiums, which are weighted based on 2018 county enrollment as of May 2018. The premiums below are for a 27-year old single nonsmoker.
